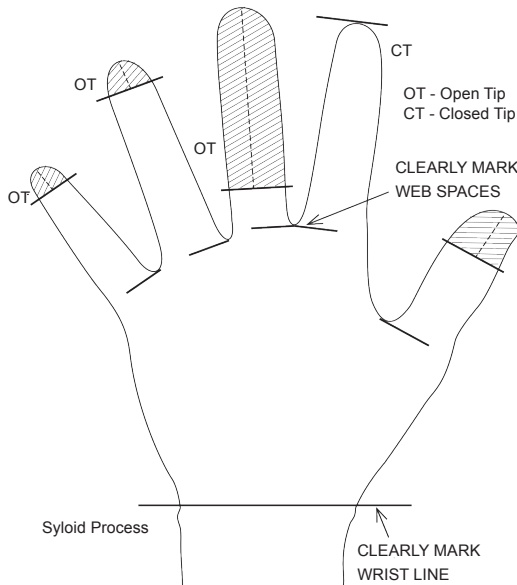

Gloves & gauntlets definition, hints and tips

Gauntlet measurements required: palm, thumb, wrist and any arm measurements needed. The hand outline must be completed.

The important points to mark on the hand trace are the web spaces, wrist and finishing point of glove.

If fingers are contracted, measure from the web space along the side of the fingers and follow the curve to the desired length of each finger.

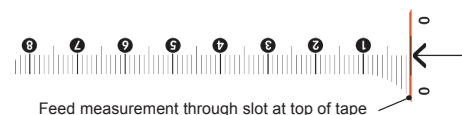
A glove to wrist may extend up to tape 3.

Finger Circumferences: Take with a JOBSKIN finger tape and measure in skin contact - not tightly.

Finger Lengths: Can be taken with the JOBSKIN Handy-card.

Open Tips: Measure only the length desired from the Finger Web Space (palmar aspect).

Slant Inserts: Enable a snug fit on the dorsal surface and give extra pressure in the web spaces.



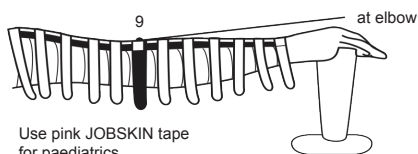
Use the finger tape to measure finger circumferences of hand. Use the purple tape for the arm.

Web Spacers: Are designed to give extra pressure in the web spaces and are worn over gloves. They can be ordered with or without a thumb piece.

Zipppers: May be used to allow for inserts, e.g. silicone gel sheets.

Arm measuring tips

With the arm straight and horizontal, proceed to measuring using a purple tape.



Use pink JOBSKIN tape for paediatrics.

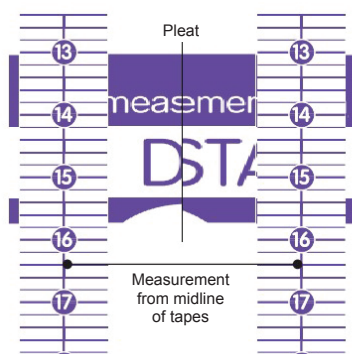
For a Full Length Sleeve begin by securing tape 9 directly around the elbow. The last tape should fall just below the wrist bone (distal to styloid process). Pleating at the spine occurs ONLY at the wrist and axilla if required.

For a Forearm Sleeve begin tape at wrist and pleat at proximal end if required.

For Elbow Contracture Seam record the degrees of deficit in range of motion.

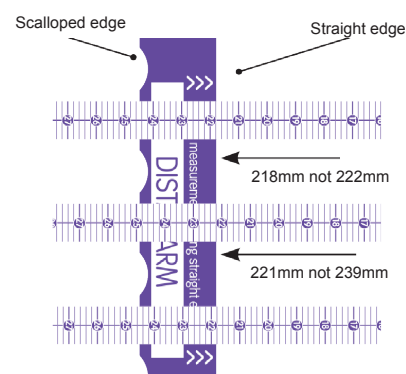
Pleat instructions

When pleating the last tape, measure the distance between the pleated tape and its neighbour from mid point to mid point (see diagram).



Reading the tapes

Always read along the straight edge and in direction of arrows as indicated below.
